The Home, has 48 children as of close of June 45 boys and 22 girls though some have been sick and we had several admissions at Maranatha and Buhinga despite the challenges, the operation is going on well. The staff member fine and doing a great job.

Activities

Baptism: 10 children were baptized into the catholic church it took place at babies home.

New Admissions.

This month of June we admitted two children at Toro babies Home, one girl Alisemera Joy who lost her mother when she was just one week old from Bundibugyo District, the relatives are unable to take care of her that is why she was referred to Toro Babie Home by the probation officer for care and protection. she was admitted at maranatha and liter referred to Buhinga Hospital, she had difficulties in Breathing due to cough and flue. She is now improving.

Two, Baguma Ezekiel who was abandoned in a banana firm by un known

person, He was later rescued by the firm manager who had the baby crying who reported the case to the police and probation officer who referred the baby to Toro Babies Home for care and protection. The baby is in a good healthy condition

physiotherapy sessions: We have had several sessions at Toro babies' home both with the kyaninga staff and the care takers. This session has helped these children so much Maria Masiika can walk up and down without any ones support she is now used to the surrounding and very strong.

Gift Ninsiima is very strong and does the exercise with ease, she can feed herself every food and drinks, she has also improved on her communication.

School:

We have 13 children who go to early bird nursery school and two who go to canon Apollo primary school, these two reported back to school though they reported a bit late, they are all in good health condition one Mbabazi Dorothy did not report back to school because of her poor healthy she is still under monitoring and medication we hope she will improve with time.

Our other classes for the young babies are on going at Home with Teacher Irine and the volunteers these classes are very important they keep the babies busy and prepare them for nursery school next year.

- iv. There is need for security camera system for addition support to the only security guard at TBH.

- 2. Construction of houses at our different farms need urgency.
- 3. Continuous healthy talks this will improve on health of the babies.
- 4. Installation of security camera at TBH to improve on the security and supporting the only security guard.
- 5. Continuous sensitization of mothers on hygiene and child care to overcome the issue of infections at the Home.
